This three day course is only available to participants who have completed the TEACCH Five-Day Hands-on Training. You will have the opportunity to refine the skills that were learnt previously and explore methodology to extend the TEACCH program within your environments.

This is the second prerequisite in the TEACCH Professional Certification Program.

Fundamentals of Structured TEACCHing and Behaviour Management for Students with ASD.

The premise of this foundation is an understanding of the learning styles of individuals with ASD and how to use teaching strategies that capitalize on learning strengths.

An emphasis is placed on the use of Structured TEACCHing principles to teach individuals with ASD skills in the areas of academics (literacy and numeracy), communication, independence, social and leisure, vocational, relaxation and coping strategies.

TRAINING OBJECTIVES

At the completion of training, participants will be able to:

Understand the unique learning styles of children and adolescents with ASD
Conduct informal assessments to set learning objectives and monitor

progress • Create meaningful and individualized visual structure for students with ASD

• Create meaningful and individualized visual structure for students with ASD in both individual and group settings

- Implement Structured TEACCHing strategies to facilitate the development of academics skills (literacy and numeracy), communication, independence, social and leisure skills, and vocational skills
- Conduct a behavioral assessment and implement problem solving approaches to reduce behavioral difficulties
- Develop and implement relaxation and coping interventions

• Implement strategies for working and collaborating with families of individuals with ASD







These courses are designed for educators, allied health practitioners and those who are interested in educational strategies and intervention programs for children and adolescents with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

STRUCTURED TEACHING



The intervention approach created by TEACCH is called Structured TEACCHing (see Mesibov, Shea, & Schopler, 2005). Structured TEACCHing is an array of teaching or treatment principles and strategies based on our understanding of the unique cognitive abilities, learning characteristics, and socialcommunication abilities associated with ASD.

Structured TEACCHing recognises the unique strengths and challenges faced by individuals with ASD including difficulties with attention and executive function and strengths in visual information processing.

Given this unique profile, Structured TEACCHing includes:

• External organizational supports to address challenges with attention and executive function

• Visual and/or written information to support verbal communication

Structured TEACCHing is not a curriculum, but instead is a framework within which educational and therapeutic goals can be achieved.

This framework includes:

- Physical organization
- Individualized schedules
- Work systems
- Visual structure of materials

TRAINING SETTING

The training workshops will be delivered at Melton Specialist School. Demonstration environments will be set up and equipped in accordance with Structured TEACCHing principles.

Your training registration cost includes all resources, training materials, morning/afternoon tea and lunch over the course of the workshops.




